Lesley Constable will host a participatory dialogue titled ***From Vision to Poetic Form: A Jungian Perspective*** using her latest published poetry to illustrate the process from inspiration to finished poem. The discussion will focus on the secondary step of poetry, in which the material from the subconscious mind meets or co-joins with the conscious mind.

Poets are invited to bring their original poems to contribute to an Open Mic and dialogue.

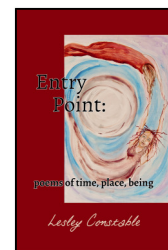
Lesley Constable is visiting Ohio and introducing her latest volume of poetry at the Jung Haus on Sunday, November 1, from 3-5pm. Admission is free and open to the public.

Lesley is a two-time graduate of OSU, with a B.A. in journalism and M.A. in art criticism, and was art critic for “The Columbus Dispatch,” “New Art Examiner,” “Dialogue, an arts journal,” and other arts publications during the 1980s-90s. A regular fixture in the Columbus arts scene, she was also recognized as a visual artist, exhibiting frequently in solo and group exhibitions including the Jung Haus Gallery.

Her poetry has been published in numerous journals and web-sites. She was finalist for the 2013 Mary Ballard/Casey Shay Press Poetry Prize, featured in A Room of Her Own foundation’s “Rad-brief” competition. She was web-arts-site Sayulita Strange “poet laureate” and featured on Poets Against War, a Canadian-based international poetry web-site.

Currently, she divides her time between the US, Mexico and Europe. She is an active, founding member of Open Borders Poetry Foundation, an international poetry collective which hosts regular multi-disciplinary poetry events. Constable is in the process of founding a literary small press in the UK.

Lesley’s latest volume of poetry, *Entry Point: poems of time, place, being*, will be available for purchase at the event.
